This is an open discussion in a field setting on a working ranch, so dress in field attire. Long pants and closed toed shoes are a must.

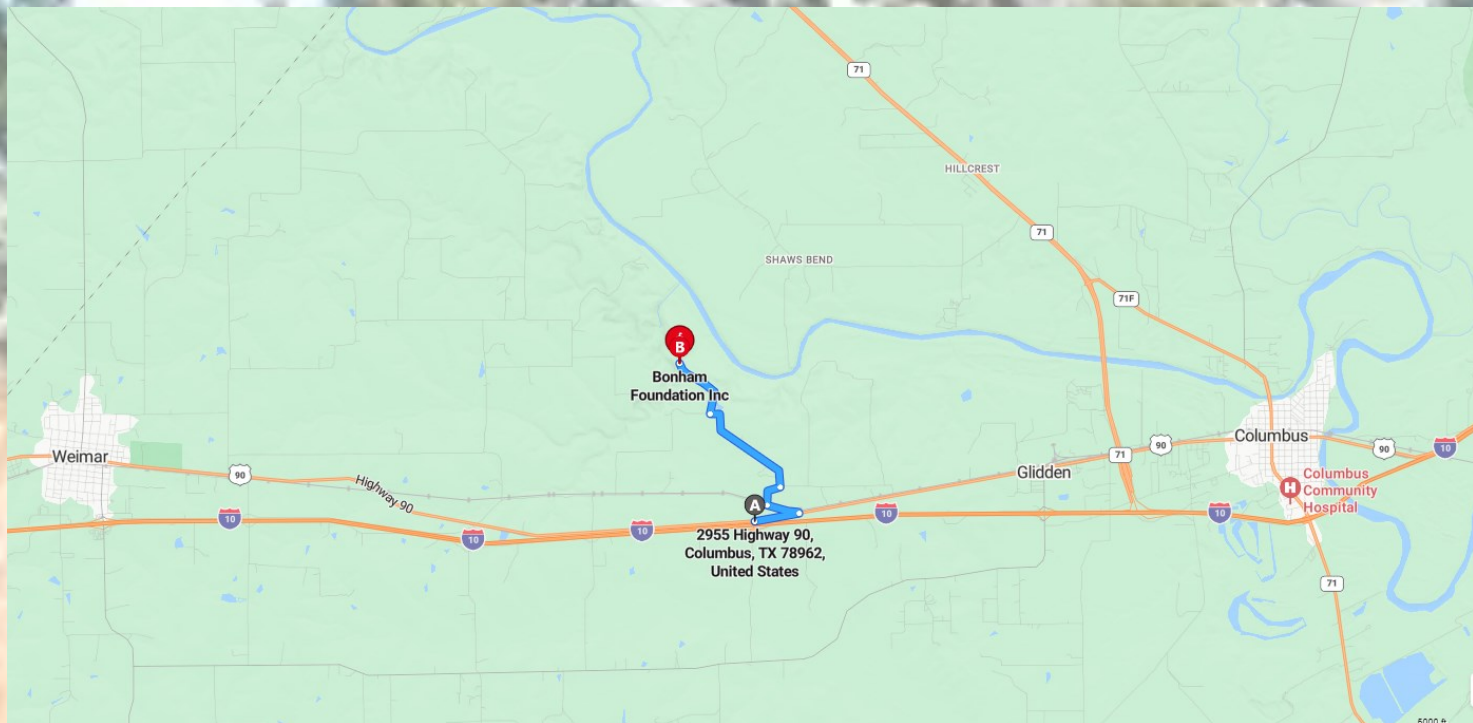
